### 2021 SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The Allen County Bar Association is sponsoring two \$1,000 scholarships. These scholarships will be awarded to the authors of the two best essays submitted. In order to participate, an applicant must be a high school senior in Allen County and with plans to attend an institution of higher education next fall.

The applicant must submit a written essay by April 26, to the Allen County Bar Association Scholarship Committee, c/o Tamara Bell, Third District Court of Appeals, 204 N. Main St., Lima, OH 45801. Essays may also be submitted by email to [tbell@third.courts.state.oh.us](mailto:tbell@third.courts.state.oh.us). Email entries must have a cover page containing the same information that written essays have. A new method of submission this year is through the Allen County Bar Association's website. The essay should address the following:

**Should colleges be permitted to require COVID vaccines before allowing students to participate in on-campus activities such as dorm life and classes?**

The awards are performance based and will be given as a one-time award to the two best essays as selected by the Allen County Bar Association Scholarship Committee.
